WAKESHMA TOWNSHIP CEMETERY LOTS APPROVED OCTOBER 1, 2007

This document amends all previous ordinances on requirements of cemetery lots in Wakeshma Township.

- 1. Grave digger must carry own liability insurance or bond. Present proof to the township board.
- 2. No spreading shrubs or trees may be placed on gravesites without written permission from township board. Refuse such as dried flowers, wreaths, and papers must be disposed of in such a manner as not to litter.
 - a. No edging stones, coping, fences, railing of hedge to define the lot or grave space shall be permitted.
 - b. Mounds which hinder the free use of a lawn mower or other equipment used for removal of grass are prohibited.
- 3. Five inch ground level cement margin around all markers or monuments.
- 4. Two cremation's burials per site.
- 5. Resident burial sites shall be sold at the rate of \$200.00 per site to Wakeshma Township Resident Property Owners only. A Resident Property Owner shall be a person who at the time of death maintains his or her permanent residence in Wakeshma Township and owns property in Wakeshma Township.

NOTE FOR ITEM 5 LOTS MAY BE PURCHASED PRIOR TO DEATH.

- 6. Non-Property Owning Residents must meet a five (5) year minimum residency requirement to be eligible to purchase cemetery lots under the provisions of item number 5.
- 7. A Resident Property Owner may purchase a grave site at the rate of \$200.00 each to bury a single adult son and/or daughter living away from home if there is no other family.
- 8. A Resident Property Owner may purchase a grave site at the rate of \$200.00 each to bury a parent, if no previous provisions have been made.
- 9. Lots may be given at time of death to persons who have resided in Wakeshma Township for the previous 25 years.

- 10. Lots may be given at any time to Resident Property Owners in Wakeshma Township who have resided in the township for a minimum of 40 years.
- 11. Non-resident burial sites are \$900.00 per site and also may be purchased prior to death.
- 12. Wakeshma Township will repurchase any cemetery lot or site from the owner for the original price paid upon written request of said owner or his/her legal heirs or representative and surrender the ownership certificate.
- 13. All Mausoleums must be constructed of first quality granite or marble. To erect a single Mausoleum a minimum of two (2) sites must be purchased. To erect a double Mausoleum a minimum of three (3) sites must be purchased. Maximum height is four (4) feet shall be allowed.
